**Why should you vote?**

- It is a civil right, It has taken many years for women, African Americans, and other citizens to gain the right to vote.

**Deadlines!**

1. Mail in registration no later than October 6, 2008
2. Hand your registration in no later than October 6, 2008
3. Vote November 4, 2008!
